7. I try to understand people's feelings
8. I pay attention to the non-verbal messages other people send
9. I try to figure out what other people are feeling just by looking at them
10. People really like to open up to me about how they feel.
11. I wish I could turn invisible in order to spy on people.
12. I think to myself how cool it would be to be an investigative reporter
13. I think about how great it would be to interview people as a career.
14. I feel comfortable asking people about their private lives.
15. I think I would make a good private detective.
16. If I found someone's diary, I would read it.
17. I think that people's private lives are fascinating.

Scoring

Total scale = sum all 17 items

Snooping subscale = sum 1, 2, 3, 4, 5

Curious about Emotions subscale = sum 6, 7, 8, 9, 10

Spying and Prying subscale = sum 11, 12, 13, 14, 15
